Unit definition²

One Unit of Citrate synthase is defined as the amount of enzyme required to produce one μ mole of citric acid from oxaloacetic acid and acetyl-coenzyme A per minute at 37°C, under the following assay conditions:

Tris/HCl buffer, pH 8.0	95.00 mM
KCI	500.00 mM
Oxaloacetic acid	0.60 mM
Acetyl-coenzyme A	0.30 mM
DTNB [5,5'-Dithiobis (2-nitrobenzoic acid)]	0.30 mM

Storage and use conditions.

The enzyme is supplied as an ammonium sulphate suspension and should be stored at +2/+8 °C. For assay, this enzyme should be diluted in 100 mM imidazole buffer, pH 8.0 containing 300 mM KCl. Swirl to mix the enzyme suspension immediately prior to use.
